Values Cards

The American Revolution was fueled not just on battlefields and in legislatures, but also around tables, taverns, and church halls where ideas were shared and solidarity was built.

Timed with America's 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence and inspired by **THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION** from Ken Burns, Sarah Botstein, and David Schmidt, this resource is designed to help communities celebrate together, explore themes of service, and reflect on the founding ideals of our nation.

The Declaration of Independence closes with a powerful commitment: "And for the support of this Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes and our sacred Honor." This pledge reminds us that even people of different backgrounds can unite around shared values—a spirit that continues to guide us in building common purpose today.

Values cards are one way to bring this spirit to life. Simple yet powerful, they invite us to reflect on what matters most and imagine how to put our values into action. Each card names a value and offers a short definition, creating opportunities to pause, connect, and be inspired.

Designed for people of all ages, the cards spark meaningful conversations, deepen understanding, and help us find common ground. Participants can choose cards that represent their personal values, explore how those values appear in their lives or in history, and even add their own using the blank cards provided. By focusing on the ideals that shaped our past and the values that guide us today, the cards encourage us to better understand one another, discover shared motivations for service, and honor the past while building a more inclusive and connected future together.

There are many ways to use these cards. Here are seven ideas:

- 1. **Connect and Share:** Invite participants to each choose a value card that matters most to them and share why with a partner or small group.
- **2. Founders and Values Match:** Link values to people involved in The American Revolution. Which values might have guided their actions?
- **3. Story of a Value:** Participants write, tell, draw, or paint a short story from their life that connects to a chosen value.
- **4. Create Your Own:** Encourage guests to write in a value that's missing and explain what it means to them.

- **5. Values Wall:** Set up a wall or board where participants can post their selected values for all to see and reflect on community patterns.
- **6. Action Challenge:** In groups, select three shared values and design a quick idea for a service project that brings those values to life.
- **7. Legacy Letters:** Ask participants to write a short note to a future generation, explaining a value they hope will shape the nation's next 250 years.
